



**C. Dependent *Student's* Income Information to Be Verified**

1. **TAX RETURN FILERS**—**Important Note:** If the student filed, or will file, an amended 2022 IRS tax return, the student must contact the Financial Aid Office before completing this section.

**Instructions:** Complete this section if the student filed or will file a 2022 income tax return with the IRS. *As part of federal student aid eligibility, students are required to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is ineffective. In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2022 income information that was transferred into the student's FAFSA using income and tax information directly from the IRS.*

If 2022 income tax return information for the student was not available or could not be used, the student must provide the institution with a 2022 IRS Tax Return Transcript(s) or a freshly signed copy of the 2022 federal income tax return and applicable schedules. To obtain an IRS tax return transcript, go to www.irs.gov and click on the “Get Your Tax Record” link, or call 1-800-908-9946. Make sure to request the “IRS tax return transcript” and **NOT** the “IRS tax account transcript.” You will need your Social Security Number, date of birth, and the address on file with the IRS (normally this will be the address used when the 2022 IRS tax return was filed).

- The student provided consent and approval to share and import income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form. Additional income and tax information for the student is not required.
- The student income and tax information did not fully transmit from the IRS to the FAFSA form. Additional income and tax information for the student is required.

Attach copies of all 2022 IRS W-2 forms issued to the student by employers. *List every employer even if they did not issue an IRS W-2 form. If more space is needed, attach a separate page with the student's name and Social Security Number at the top.*

**D. Parent's Income Information to Be Verified**—Note: If two parents were reported in Section B of this worksheet, the instructions and certifications below refer and apply to both parents.

1. **TAX RETURN FILERS**—**Important Note:** If the student's parent(s), filed or will file, an amended 2022 IRS tax return the student's Financial Aid Office must be contacted before completing this section.

**Instructions:** Complete this section if the student's parent(s) filed or will file a 2022 income tax return with the IRS. *As part of federal student aid eligibility, parents are required to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is ineffective.
