¹Students who have successfully completed high school chemistry (official high school transcript must be submitted along with your admissions application) will not be required to complete CHE-101. An additional 3 credits in non-nursing elective course work will be required. If CHE 1500 or CHE 1530 was completed at JCC, this course will satisfy the CHE-101 requirement.

²In addition to the 18 JCC credits of Core Requirements noted above the following JCC courses will transfer to Daemen as Core Electives to complete the Daemen 45-credit Core Electives requirement: any college-level (non-imputed, 100-level or above) courses.

<u>Tuition Grants</u>: Tuition grants, not based on financial need are available to all graduate nurses and registered nurses, and underwrite up to 50% of the cost of tuition.

Nursing students transferring to Daemen College must have a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average in all coursework from their college or nursing school. Daemen College will accept grades of "D" or better from the degree granting institution/s ONLY.

Daemen will allow the transfer of up to 90 Jamestown Community College credits (the 63 credits specified above, plus CHE 1500 or CHE 1530 or if not required then the additional 3 credits in non-nursing elective course work, plus the Additional 24 credits of Non-Nursing Electives listed as remaining DC requirements) toward fulfillment of requirements for the B.S. Nursing major.
