

How to Fill Out the Proof of Support Form

The purpose of this form is to verify that you have the means to pay the cost of the entire program and then some. This is for immigration purposes:

- ✓ Make sure you fill out the entire front page.
- ✓ On the back or on the second page, you are showing the funds that are available to you for your education, books, and living expenses.
- ✓ Fill in appropriate sections to show your means of support, you only need to be concerned about the first year (1st column).
- ✓ Remember you need to show the US \$ amount.
- ✓ Your bank official needs to fill out Section A.
- ✓ If you are receiving outside funds (e.g.: parents, grandparents, friend), section B needs to be fill out by that person through a sponsor.
- ✓ **We will need official documents supporting these funds e.g.: current statements for RRSP's, Line of Credit, Loan, and if it is a personal savings, a copy of your last tax return or pay stub showing steady income.**
- ✓ Last, you need to sign and date this form and mail it to:

- ✓ *** Once we receive your proof of support, we will issue you an I-20, an immigration form and send you **both** the proof of support and the I-20 form for **you** to take to the border or visa interview.
- ✓ *** **Please Note: An additional \$200.00 US SEVIS (Homeland Security) fee has to be paid before your I-20 can be finalized. Once you receive your I-20 from Daemen, you can make this payment with a credit card at www.FMJfee.com. Print out the receipt to take to the border or the visa interview along with your I-20. *****
- ✓ There is a \$6.00 US Fee, to be paid at the border.
