CAMPUS CLIMATE SURVEY RESULTS
Spring 2017

The campus climate survey was sent out to students at Daemen College between February 23, 2017 and March 11, 2017. The survey was designed to get a sense from students as to their perception on how sexual assault, harassment, and/or related situations affected their health and well-being of the campus. The survey was sent out to 2,329 students, 290 (12.5%) students responded to the survey with only 173 (7.4%) students completing the entire survey. The results of the campus climate survey are detailed below.

Key Findings:

Of the students who responded to the survey, 92.4% felt safe on campus and in the residence halls and felt like they are a part of the Daemen community. However, 50% of respondents were not aware of Daemen College's Do Something campaign. This suggests that more information and programming regarding Do Something should be initiated on campus.

Of the students who responded to the survey, 85% had positive experiences and feelings regarding faculty and staff members at Daemen College. 69.8% of respondents understood their rights as a student if they were to experience sexual harassment. 66.2% of respondents understood their rights as a student if they were to experience dating violence or sexual assault.

The results of the Spring 2017 Campus Climate Survey were compared to the results of the Spring 2015 Campus Climate Survey. In Spring 2015, 38.5% of respondents strongly agreed or agreed to the statement "I know where to turn for resources if I were to experience sexual harassment" while in Spring 2017, 56.4% strongly agreed or agreed. In Spring 2015, 32.7% of respondents strongly disagreed or disagreed to the statement "I know where to turn for resources if I were to experience sexual harassment" while in Spring 2017, 28.5% of respondents either strongly disagreed or disagreed.

In Spring 2015, 39.3% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed to the statement "I know where to turn for help if I feel sexually harassed" while in Spring 2017, 60.9% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed. In Spring 2015, 41.1% of respondents either strongly disagreed or disagreed to the statement "I know where to turn for help if I feel sexually harassed" while in Spring 2017, 26.5% of respondents strongly disagreed or disagreed.

In Spring 2015, 34.2% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed to the statement "I am aware of the programs and services offered by the college that deal with sexual harassment" while in Spring 2017, 45.4% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed. In Spring 2015, 45.9% of respondents either strongly disagreed or disagreed to the statement "I am aware of the programs and services offered by the college that deal with sexual harassment" while in Spring 2017, 33.9% of respondents either strongly disagreed or disagreed.

In Spring 2015, 40.8% of respondents strongly agreed or agreed to the statement “I know where to turn for resources if I were to experience sexual assault/dating violence” while in Spring 2017, 60.5% of respondents strongly agreed or agreed. In Spring 2015, 32% of respondents strongly disagreed or disagreed to the statement “I know where to turn for resources if I were to experience sexual assault/dating violence” while in Spring 2017, 26.7% of respondents strongly disagreed or disagreed.

In Spring 2015, 55.6% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed to the statement “The college promotes opportunities for healthy relationships” while in Spring 2017, 53.9% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed. In Spring 2015, .08% of respondents either strongly disagreed or disagreed to the statement “The college promotes opportunities for healthy relationships” while in Spring 2017, 7.7% strongly disagreed or disagreed.

In Spring 2015, 33% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed to the statement “If I were sexually assaulted, I would know where to turn for help on campus” while in Spring 2017, 63.9% of respondents either strongly agreed or agreed. In Spring 2015, 42% of respondents either strongly disagreed or disagreed to the statement “If I were sexually assaulted, I would know where to turn for help on campus” while in Spring 2017, 24.8% of respondents either strongly disagreed or disagreed.

In Spring 2015, 40.2% of respondents strongly agreed or agreed to the statement “If I were sexually assaulted, I would ask for help from campus administrators” while in Spring 2017, 48.5% of respondents strongly agreed or agreed. In Spring 2015, 33% of respondents either strongly disagreed or disagreed to the statement “If I were sexually assaulted, I would ask for help from campus administrators” while in Spring 2017, 25.4% of respondents either strongly disagreed or disagreed.

Future versions of the survey can be condensed as there were a few questions that had very similar or identical meanings but different wordings. These questions can be combined to reduce survey length and potentially increase the amount of student responses.
