I am writing with some exciting news. I am pleased to announce that after a national search, Daemen College has appointed Emily Burns Perryman, as vice president for institutional advancement. Her appointment is effective June 1. In this role, she will oversee the areas of fundraising, alumni relations, publications, and marketing and communications.

Ms. Perryman first joined Daemen as associate vice president of marketing and communications in August of 2019 where she was charged with leading Daemen's marketing and communications initiatives, including the development and implementation of the college's strategic marketing and branding plans.
