However, registration for [Family Orientation](#) can only take place after students have registered for New Student Orientation.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Resident student move-in and check-in will be held on September 4 from 9:00am to 12:00pm in the Yurtchuck Student Center Lobby. More details regarding the move-in process and housing placements will be sent to your Daemen email from Residence Life. Additionally, we encourage you to watch the recording of our [Wildcat Chat, Preparing for Move-In Day](#).

Orientation check-in for all first-year students and new international students will be held on September 4 from 11:00am to 2:00pm at the orientation tent located at the Yurtchuk Student Center side lawn. At this time, students will sign the Entering Class of 2026 scroll and receive their welcome bag, which includes their orientation schedule, name badge, and group assignment.

New Student Orientation is a 3-day event that includes Wildcat Welcome Day meetings and

events for new students and families on September 4, as well as information sessions throughout the weekend. Please refer to the Information Guide for New Students for details on required events.

BE READY CHECKLIST

Use this checklist to make sure you have everything ready for this fall!

- **Health Compliance**
 - Make sure you are health compliant by submitting the [necessary health requirements](#) to the CHIP Center.
 - Students who have not submitted their documentation will be indicated as not in compliance and will be removed from their registered classes. Residential students will not receive keys to their residence halls and student-athletes will not be allowed to participate in athletic activities until they are in compliance.

- **Computer Account**
 - [Activate your Daemen University email and computer account](#) to gain access to the MyDaemen portal.
- **Student ID Card**
 - [Upload your picture](#) for your student ID card.
 - Students must have activated their Daemen computer account to upload their ID picture.
 - ID cards will be available for pickup beginning August 1 at the Campus Safety desk located in the Yurtchuk Student Center.
- **Parking Permit**
 - Students can currently [request parking permits](#) through Campus Safety.
- **Family Orientation**
 - Sign your family up for [Family Orientation](#). A detailed schedule of events can be found on the [Orientation website](#).
- **Official Score Reports and Transcripts**
 - Submit official score reports for International Baccalaureate and Advanced Placement (AP) exams to the Admissions Office.
 - Submit official transcripts from any college or university where you received college or university credits to the Admissions Office.
- **Accessibility Services**
 - If you require accommodations for orientation and/or during the academic school year, please contact Accessibility Services at access@daemen.edu or 716-839-8228. You can also visit them in the Student Success Center located on the first floor of the Research and Information Commons (RIC).
 - Please note that disability related information should be sent directly to Accessibility Services. It is not included in the academic records your school sends to admissions.
- **Daemen Connect Smartphone App**
 - It is important that students download the [Daemen Connect app](#) as it will be used to check in to all required orientation meetings September 4-6, and at all First-Year Experience programs throughout the year.
 - The Daemen Connect app can be downloaded on the App Store or Google Play.
 - The Daemen Connect app will be used throughout the year to notify students of upcoming events, learn about clubs and organizations, and share updates about what is going on around campus.
