WELCOME TO THE WILDCAT FAMILY!



Dear Wildcats,

We are thrilled that you have decided to attend Daemen University! Whether you are attending college for the first time or transferring to Daemen University from another institution, understanding new policies and processes can be a bit overwhelming.

We want to assist in making your start of the semester as easy as possible with regard to viewing, understanding, and paying your tuition bill, which is why we have created this reference piece to help guide you.

WHEN WILL MY BILL BE AVAILABLE?

Tuition bills will be available beginning July 8, and payment is due by July 29, 2026.

VIEWING YOUR TUITION BILL

You can view your bill in Self-Service in the MyDaemen portal. To view your tuition bill:

1. Log in to [MyDaemen](#)
2. Click 'Self-Service'
3. Click 'Student Finance' then 'Continue to Account Info/Payment Center'

If you are logging in for the first time, several notices will be brought to your attention. You will need to acknowledge these and digitally sign the consents before you are able to move on and view your billing information.

Please note that tuition bills will only be available for students registered for Fall courses. Students who register after this date will have their statement available on Self-Service within a few business days of registration.

Make sure that any aid you received from your Financial Aid award package is listed on the bill.

Please note that a Federal Work Study (FWS) award is not directly applied to your student bill. Students who work will receive a bi-weekly paycheck. The amount listed on your financial aid award letter reflects the maximum amount you may earn during the 2026-2027 academic year. Students who are eligible for FWS will have an opportunity to apply for jobs posted on the [Daemen University Employee Engagement Student Employment website](#). An FWS award does not guarantee a job placement.

PAYING YOUR BILL

You have the option to pay your bill in person or electronically. Bills must be paid in full, fully covered by Financial Aid, or on a payment plan by the due date to avoid several late fees.

In-Person:

You are welcome to visit the Student Accounts office in Duns Scotus 112 to pay your bill in person, by cash, or by check made payable to Daemen University.

Electronically:

You are also welcome to pay your bill online in [Self-Service](#) under 'Student Finance' and then click 'Continue to Account Info/Payment Center.' There are two payment options to choose from - electronic check payments (no service fee) and credit card/debit card ([a service fee will apply](#)). When paying online, you will have the option to save your banking information in the system for future payments. You can also set up a refund profile for any refunds or credits you may receive to be directly deposited into your account.

PAYMENT PLAN OPTIONS

While some students choose to pay their bill at once, many students find it easier to pay in small installments and use a payment plan. Students can sign up for a monthly payment plan with a \$40 setup fee. Payment Plans can be paid off ahead of schedule without penalty.

CAN I ADD AN AUTHORIZED USER?

Yes! You can give others (parents, employers, etc.) the ability to access your account information. In compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy ACT of 1974 (FERPA), your student financial records may not be shared with a 3rd party without your consent. Adding an authorized user is your written consent that an individual may view your account information and make payments on your behalf. Please note that authorized users DO NOT have access to your stored payment methods, academic records, or other personal information.

To add an authorized user:

1. Log in to [Self-Service](#)
2. Click on 'Student Finance and then 'Continue to Account Info/Payment Center'
3. Go to 'My Profile'
4. Choose authorized users and add authorized users

SAVINGS ON TEXTBOOKS THROUGH THE ALL-ACCESS PASS PROGRAM

Daemen University has partnered with Barnes & Noble to provide books to our students through the [All-Access Pass Program](#).

All-Access Pass is a textbook rental program that lowers the cost of books and ensures students

have their required course materials on the first day of class. The All-Access Pass program allows the University's Bookstore partner, Barnes & Noble College, to purchase materials for all courses in bulk, significantly reducing prices for students.

IMPORTANT: **ALL** students will be billed for the required textbooks based on the number of credits registered.

- [OPT OUT of All Access Program](#): Students can opt out of the All Access Program between the dates of July 27, 2026, and September 22, 2026. Please allow 1-2 business days for the All Access Pass charge to be removed from your tuition bill.
