The estimated cost of additional years for commuter students is based on full-time undergraduate status commuting to campus.

Students in the Nursing 1+2+1 program attend an area partner community college (SUNY Erie, SUNY Niagara and Genesee Community College) in both year 2 and 3 of the program. All classes are held at the partner school; tuition and any course-related fees are charged by the community college the student attends. Students may still live on campus at Daemen University during the middle two years of the program; however, all aid, including loans to assist in paying for housing expenses, must be arranged through the partner school.
