You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid administrator at your school. Your school may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact your financial aid administrator as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

Instructions: Complete this section if the student <u>filed or will file</u> a 2024 income tax return with the IRS. As part of federal student aid eligibility, students are required to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is ineffective. In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2024 income information that was transferred into the student's FAFSA using income and tax information directly from the IRS.

If 2024 income tax return information for the student (and/or spouse) was not available or could not be used, the student (and/or spouse) must provide the institution with a 2024 IRS Tax Return Transcript(s) or a freshly signed copy of the 2024 federal income tax return and applicable schedules. Make sure to request the "IRS tax return transcript" and NOT the "IRS tax account transcript." You will need your Social Security Number, date of birth, and the address on file with the IRS (normally this will be the address used when the 2024 IRS tax return was filed).
