On October 14, Governor Cuomo signed legislation designating Juneteenth, June 19, as an official state holiday. In keeping with the Governor's state-wide effort to celebrate Juneteenth, and consistent with Daemen's ongoing commitment to celebrating diversity and inclusion, I am pleased to announce that henceforth Juneteenth will be an official holiday for the college.

Juncteenth celebrates the emancipation of enslaved African Americans throughout the United States, and the college welcomes the opportunity to recognize the significance of this historic day and supports observing the date as a holiday.

Because June 19 falls on a Saturday during this academic year, we will observe this holiday on Friday, June 18, 2021. Offices will be closed and classes will not meet. When this date falls during the week, we will observe the holiday on the actual date: June 19.
