I want to thank everyone for your participation in voting for the "Best of 716" contest. Thanks to your support, Daemen was chosen as the region's "Best Local University." According to the Buffalo News, more than 220,000 ballots were cast and 35,000 nominations were received, and Daemen received more total ballots from the general public than all other finalists in the Best Local University category.

I think you will be pleased to learn that the Daemen College Board of Trustees continues to appoint tremendous leaders to the board. Earlier this month, the Board confirmed Scott Bieler as the newest trustee. Bieler is the CEO of West Herr Automotive Group and is an active philanthropist and community leader. We are thrilled to have him join the stellar group of fellow community leaders on our board.

Finally, I would like to give you an update on our rebranding project and research.
