Dear Incoming Residential Students:

We are thrilled that you will be living with us for the next academic year! While COVID-19 guidelines continue to be ever-changing, we have spent a great deal of time considering a move in plan that will keep density down on campus during this critical time. This letter is designed to give you our timeline for your move-in. We have divided our residential students into the Regions as outlined by New York State, and are using that as our basis surrounding the following move-in dates. Please note these dates are subject to change in accordance with New York State guidance and we will adhere to the quarantine guidelines that are in effect at the time of move-in.

Students are expected to arrive between 9 am and 3 pm on their assigned dates below:

August 1, 2020: International Student Athlete Move-In

August 8, 2020: International Student Move-In

August 11 & 13, 2020: Finger Lakes Region Belonging Drop Off

During this time, residential students will arrive to campus, put their belongings in their room, make it their own, and then head back home.

August 16, 2020: Fall Athlete, New HEOP Students & RA Move-In

August 18 & 20, 2020: Western New York Region Belonging Drop Off

During this time frame residential students will arrive to campus, put their belongings in their room, make it their own, and then head back home.


August 28, 2020: Long Island, Mid-Hudson, New York City Regions & Out of State Move-In

September 2, 2020: Capital, Central, Mohawk, North Country & Southern Tier Regions Move-In

September 3, 2020: Finger Lakes & Western New York Regions Key Pick-up and Move-In for the year.

We will send you details in the coming weeks regarding COVID-19 testing, move-in helpers, specific move-in instructions, and the check-in form. Part of this move-in will include mandatory diagnostic testing for COVID-19 and the antibody test, to help us with contact tracing and quarantine later on if needed. Again, more details to come but know that your health and safety is our #1 priority.
