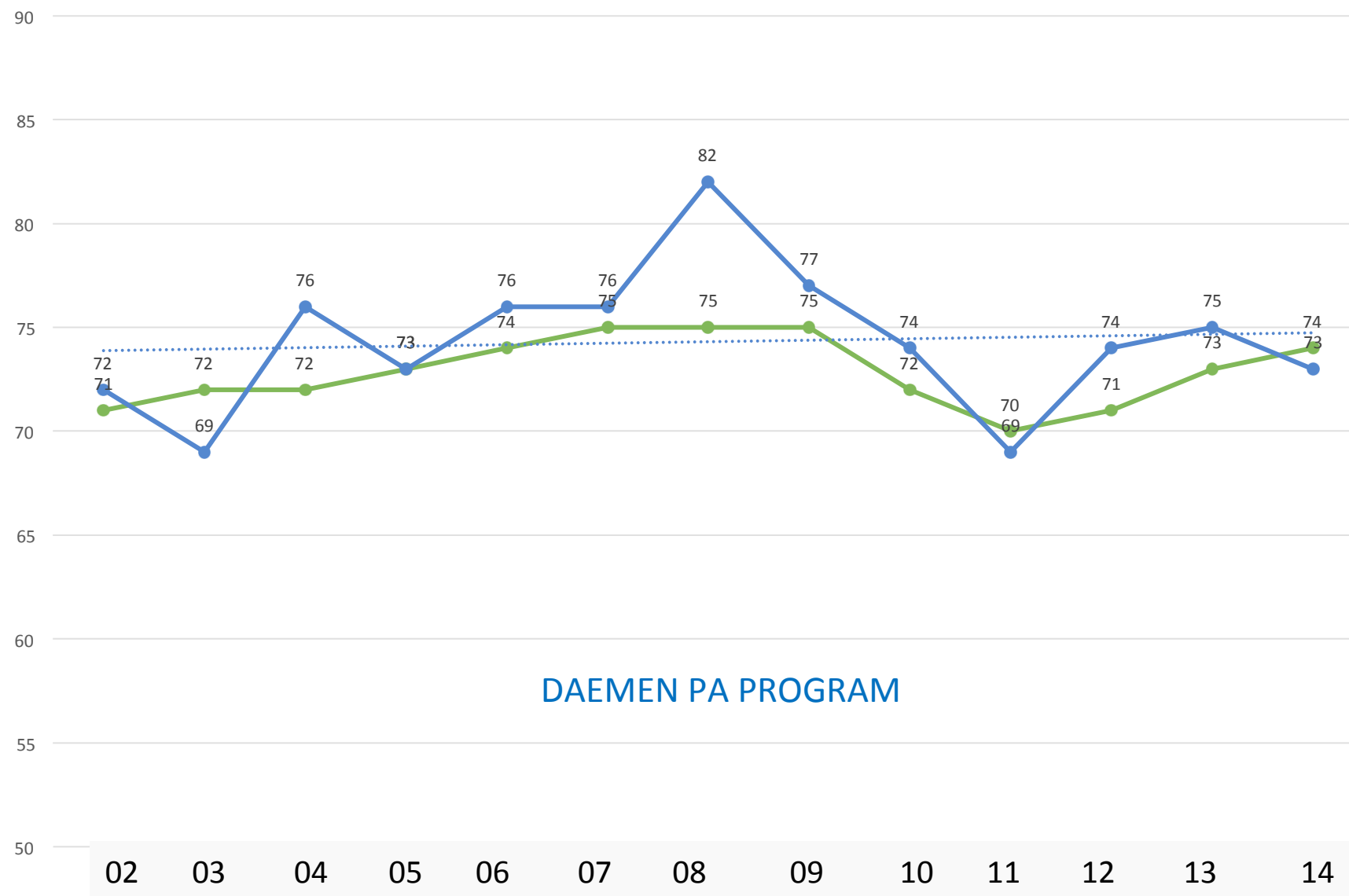

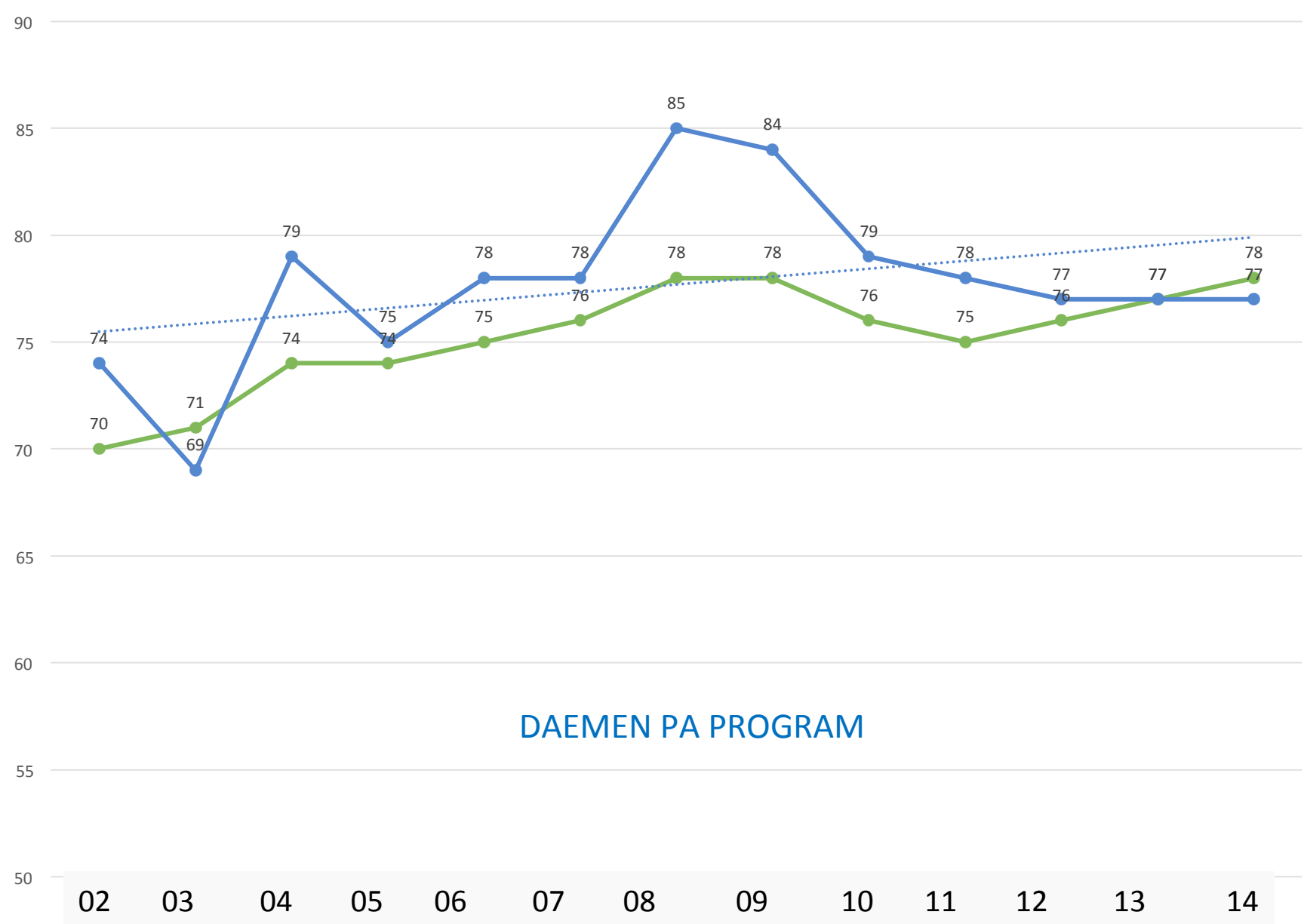
Benchmark Example #1

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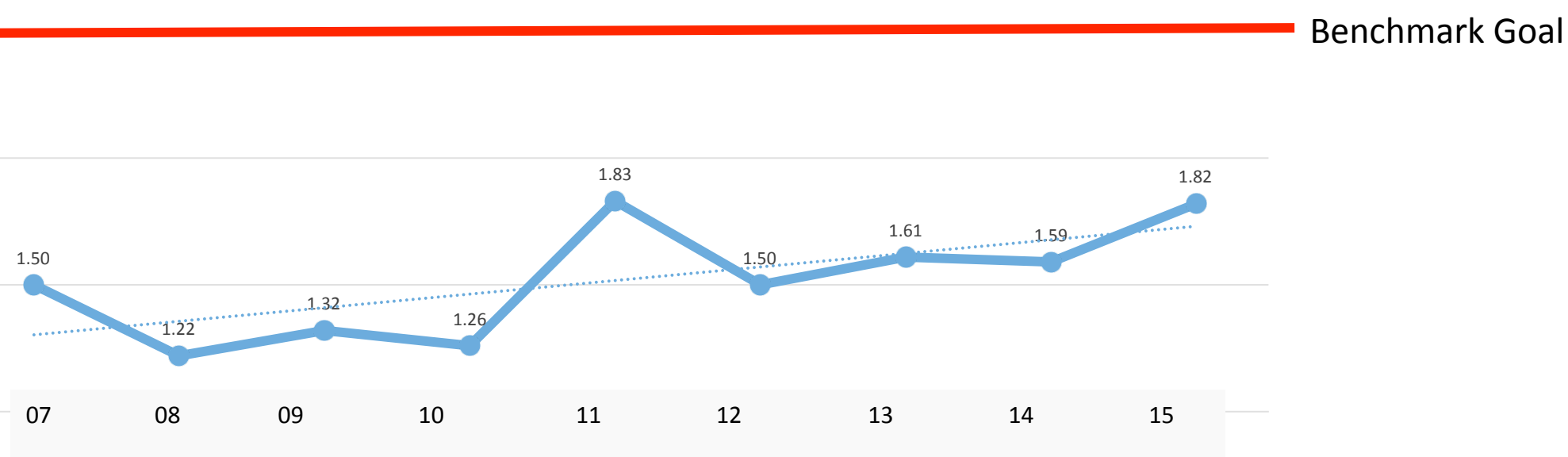

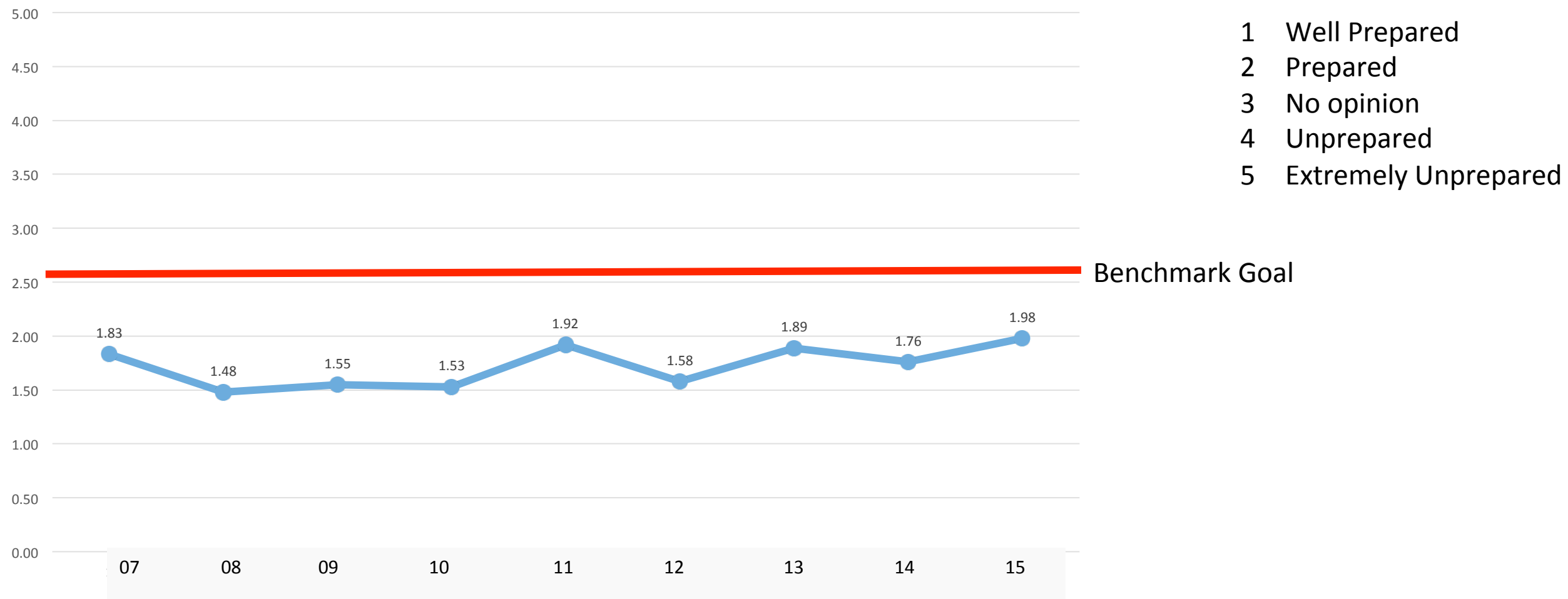

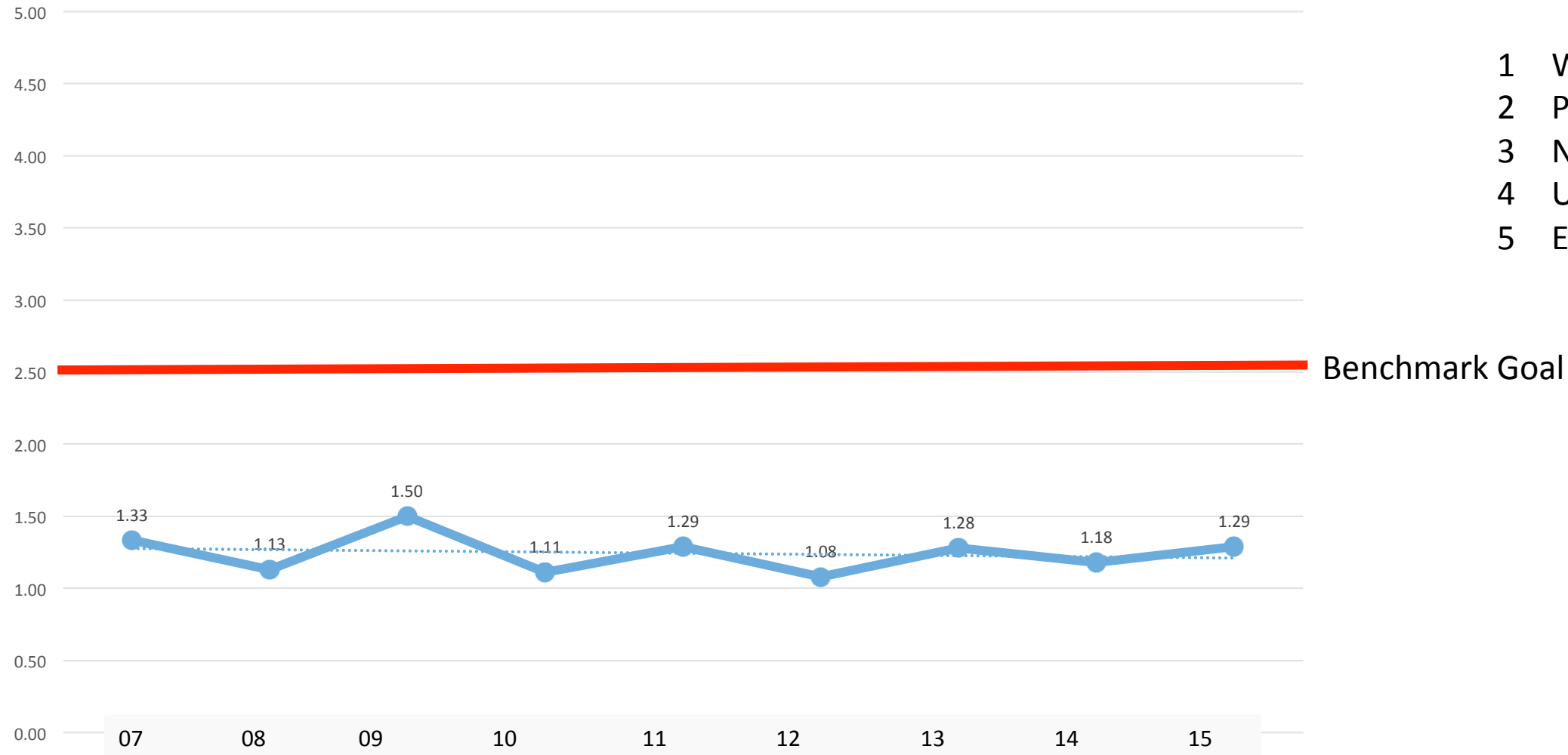

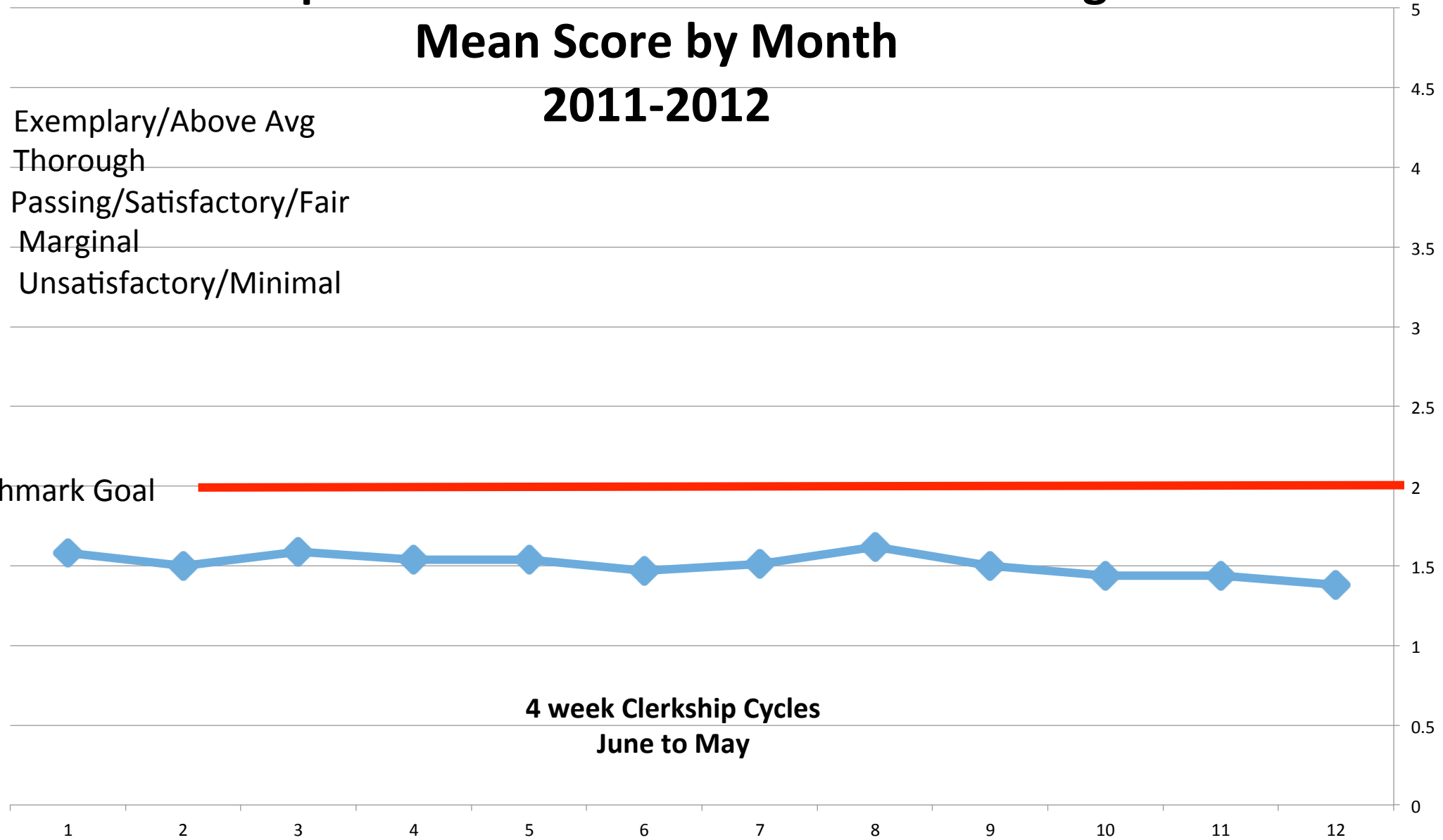

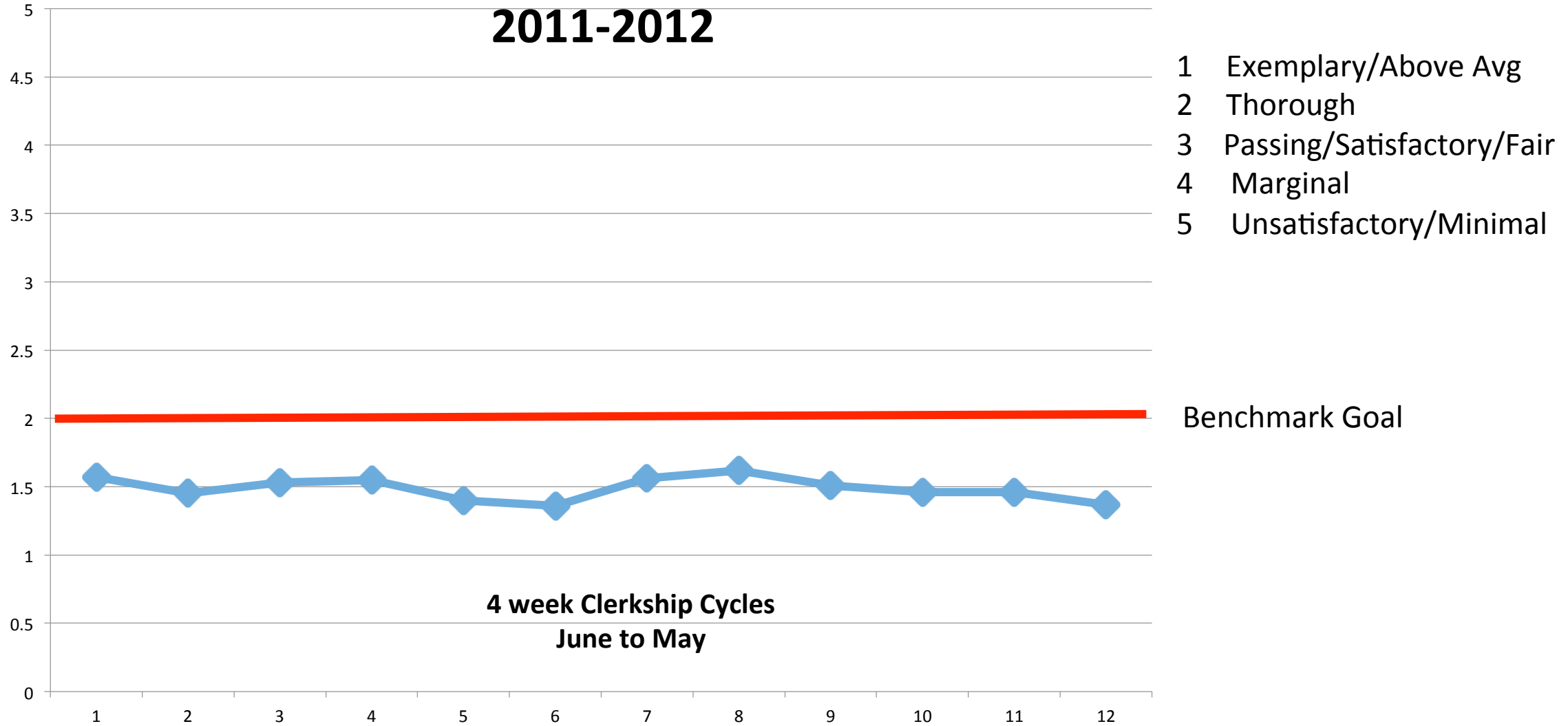

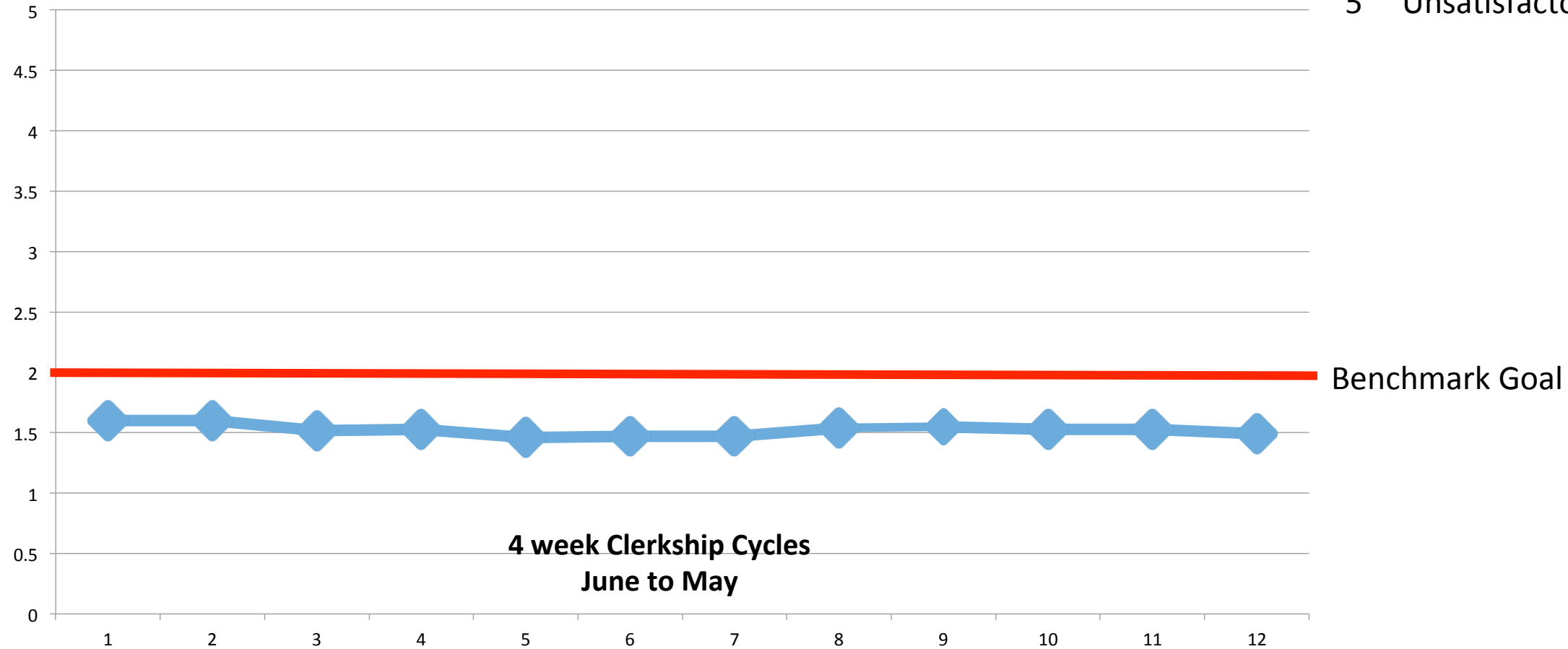


Preceptor Evaluation Of Physical Examination

Mean Score by Month

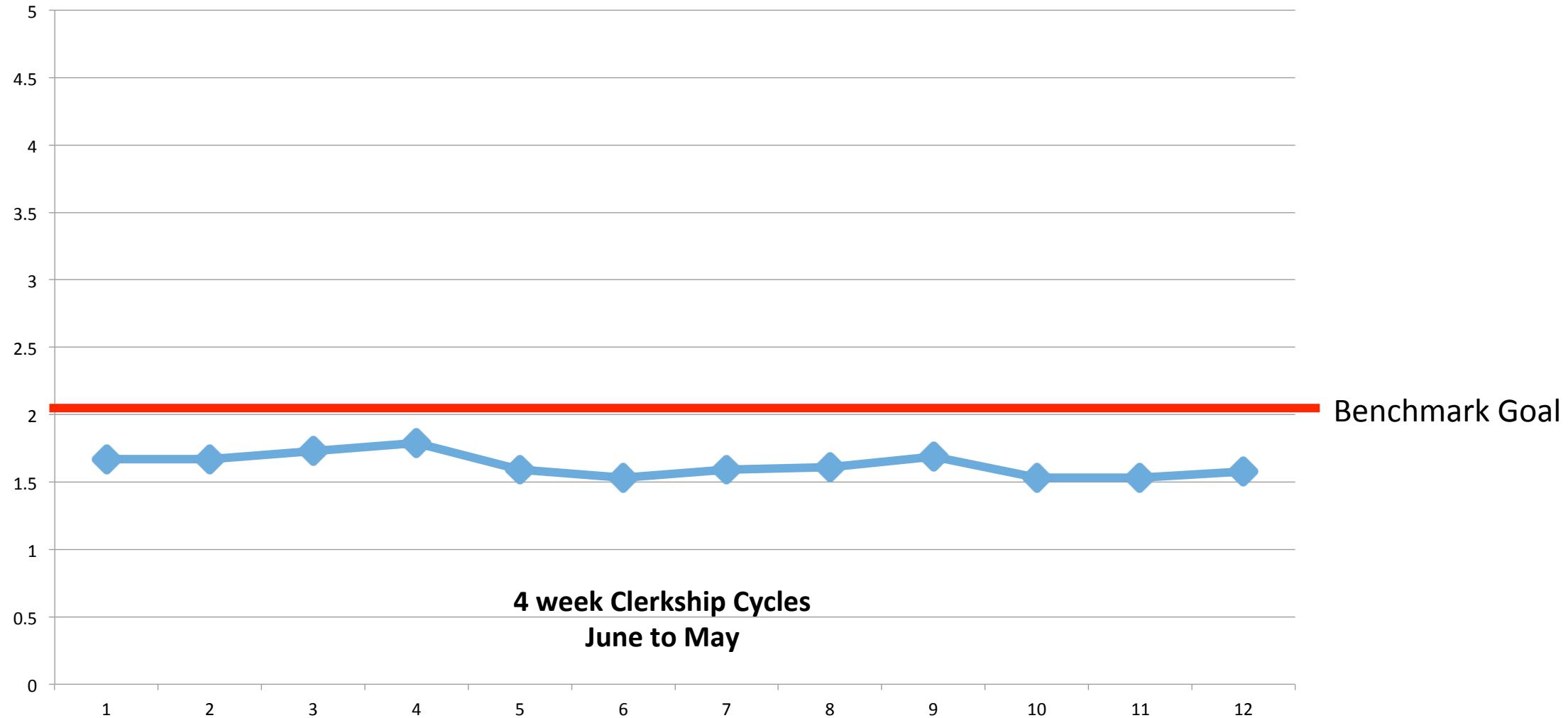

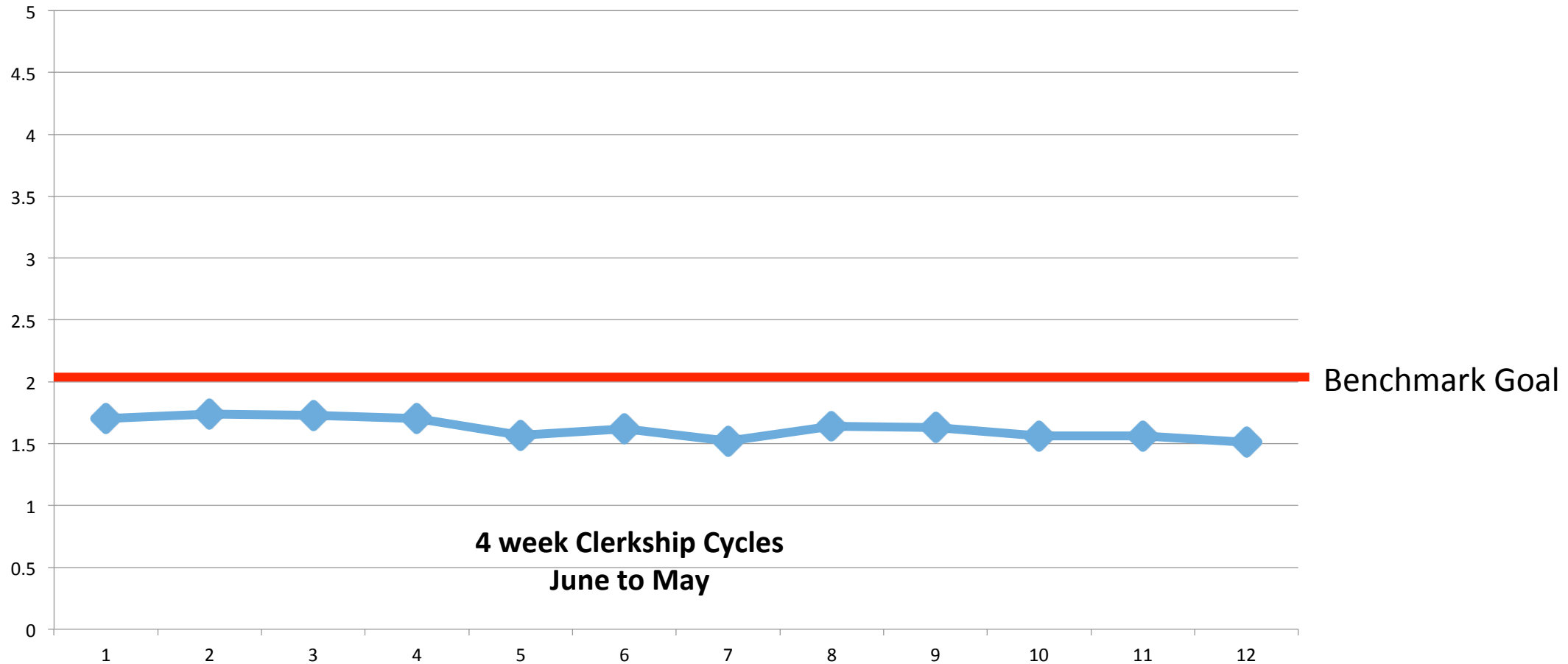
Preceptor Evaluation of Laboratory and Tests Knowledge Mean Score by Month 2011-2012

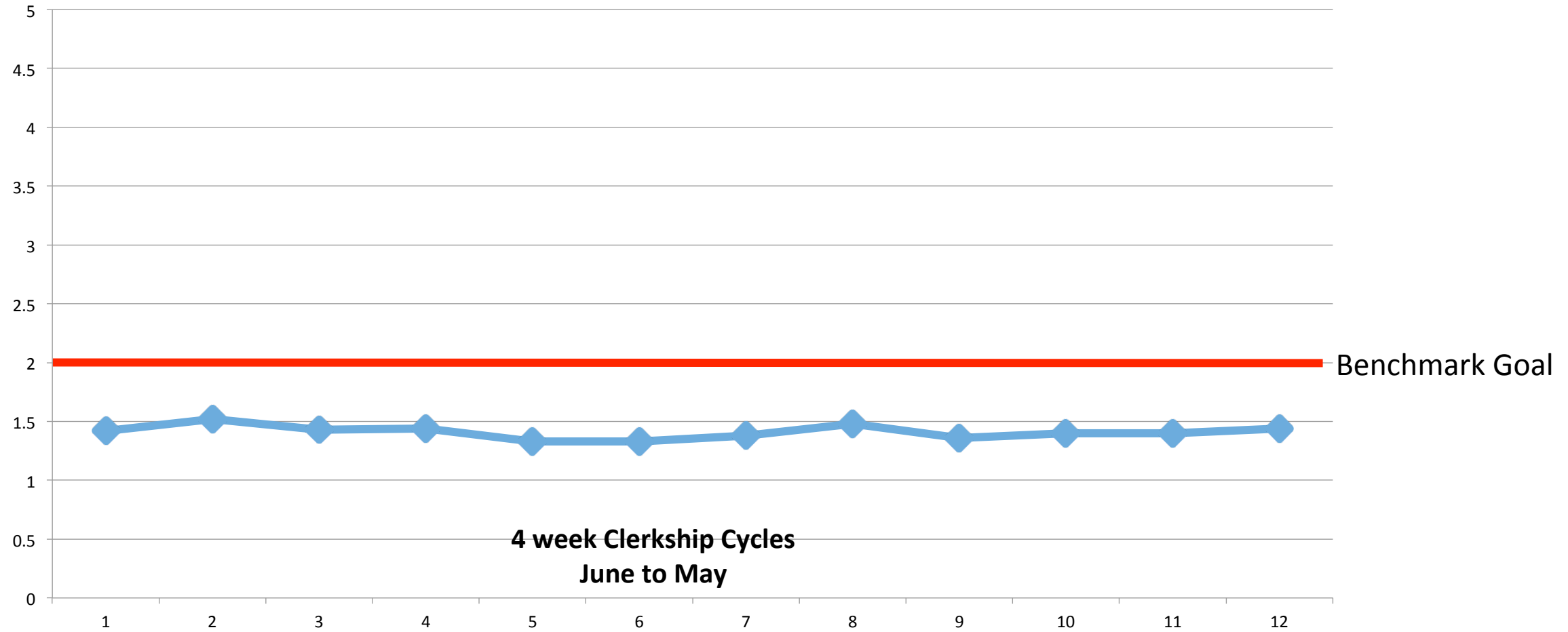
Preceptor Evaluation of Treatment Planning Mean Scores by Month 2011-2012

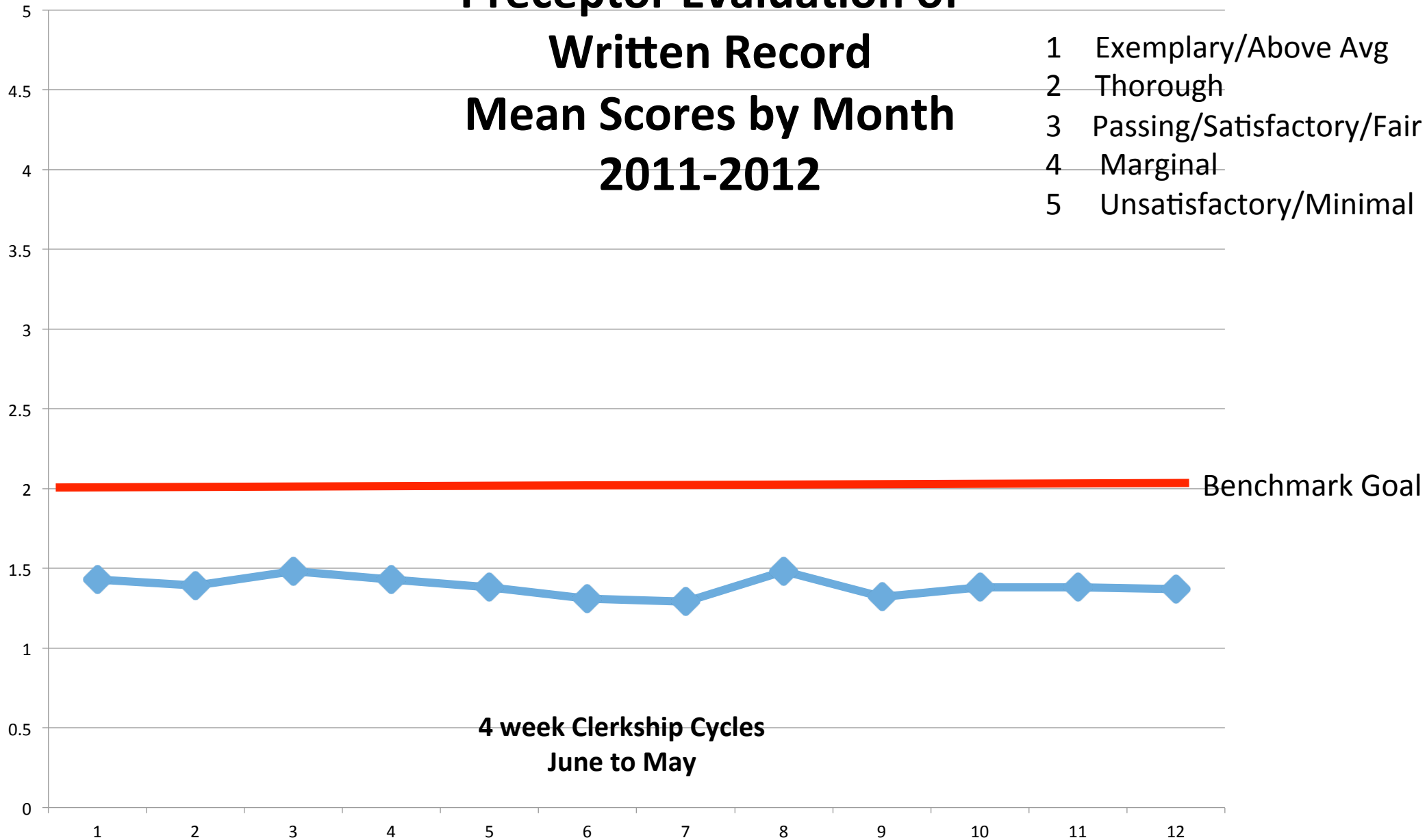
Preceptor Evaluations of Patient Presentations Mean Scores by Month 2011-2012

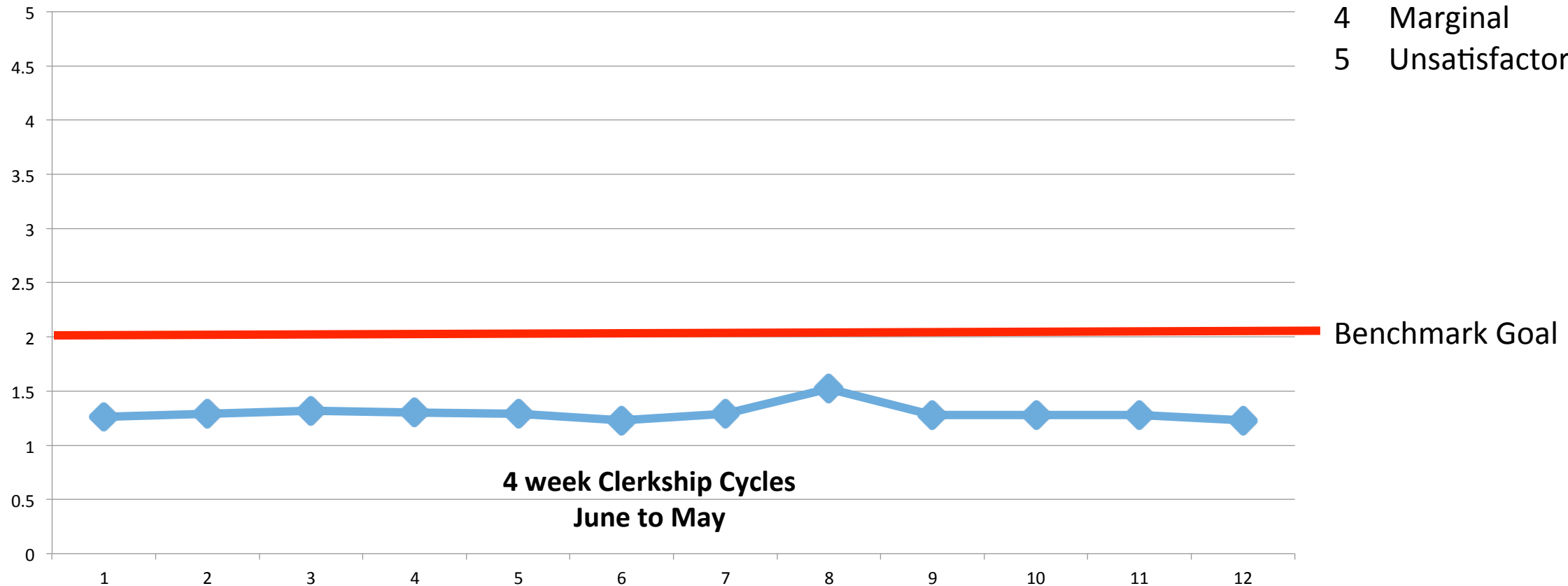
Preceptor Evaluation of Written Record Mean Scores by Month 2011-2012

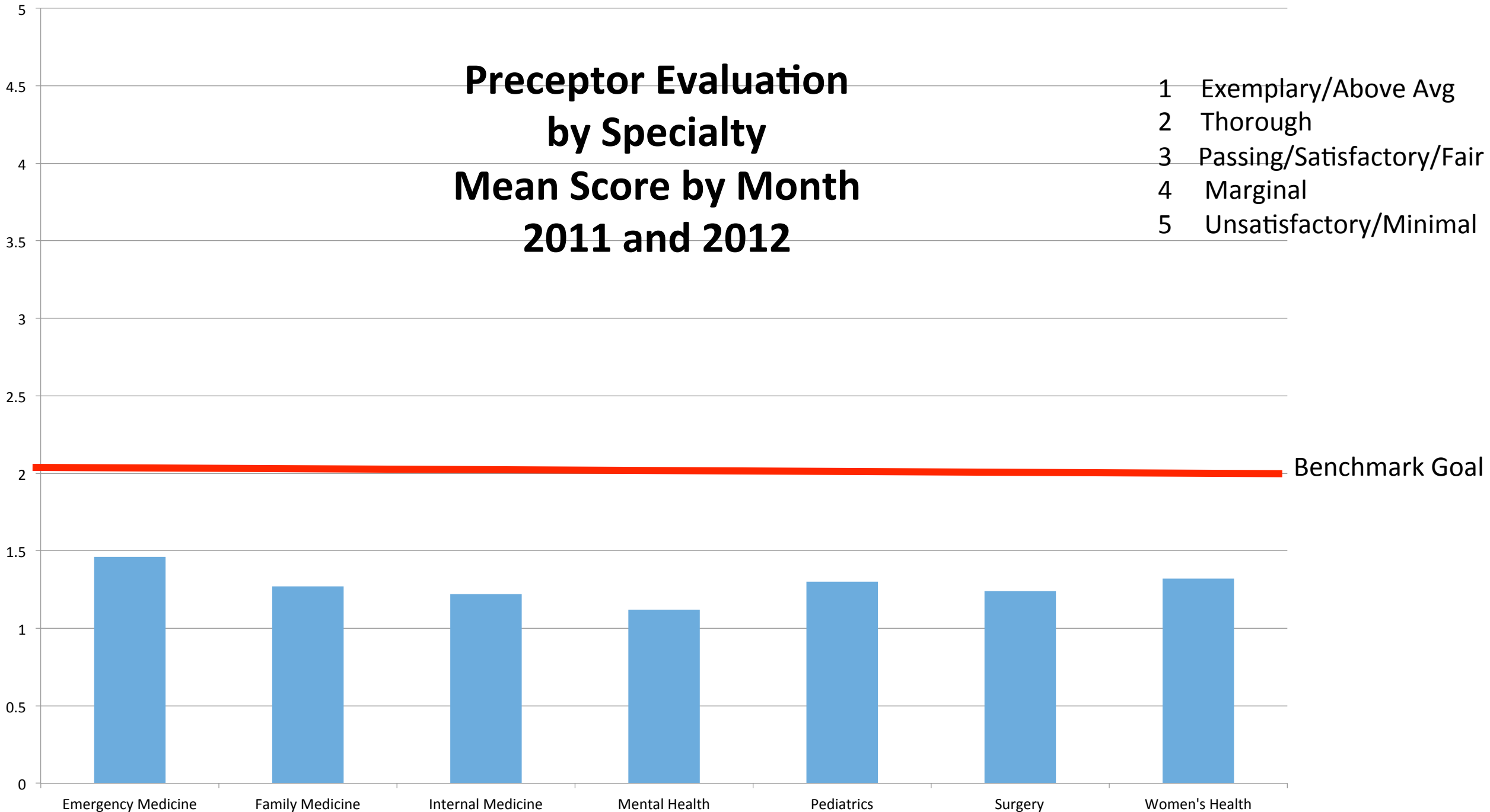
Preceptor Evaluation of Overall Competence Mean Scores by Month 2011-2012
