Statement on Racial Injustice

In the last week, we have witnessed a passionate response—including civil unrest here in Buffalo and beyond—to the killing of George Floyd. This killing of an unarmed person of color is the latest in a long string of similar incidents. These injustices demonstrate that our nation continues to struggle with systemic racism and that while some progress has been made we still have much work to do to bring about racial justice.
