Education at Daemen:

- Starting in your first year, structured field experiences in classrooms will build your confidence through meaningful interactions with Pre-K-12 students.
- Small class sizes help to facilitate enhanced interaction with faculty members who
 are dedicated to teaching excellence and providing personal attention to each

- Education students receive training in state-of-the-art instructional technology, including SMART Boards, iPads, and educational apps.
- All teacher candidates learn to value service to others through completion of 60 volunteer hours of community service.
- Daemen has a combined pass rate on the annual New York State Teacher Certification Examinations consistently above 90%.
- Faculty are well-prepared to support teacher candidates taking the updated NYS Certification tests.
- Daemen College is currently pursuing accreditation of its educator preparation programs by the Association for Advancing Quality in Educator Preparation (AAQEP). Pursuant to §52.21 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education, the educator preparation programs offered by Daemen College are considered to be continuously accredited for purposes of meeting the New York State requirement that all such programs maintain continuous accreditation.

Daemen Students Gain EXPERIENCE:

- There is an extensive range of field experience offered in the Education Program at Daemen.
- Candidates participate in diverse learning experiences through Daemen's partnerships with local public, private, and charter schools as well as educational agencies and community centers.
- Students gain field experience in a classroom setting at the on-campus Thomas Reynolds Center for Special Education and After-School Programs.
- Candidates can gain education and experience in Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) and be eligible for the credential of Registered Behavior Technician (RBT). RBTs are providers of behavioral services who work under the supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA).

NEW: Adolescence Special Education 7-12 Students with Disabilities Generalist (SwDG) (Bachelor of Science)

- Students will be eligible to teach in self-contained classrooms, in supportive roles such as special education consultant teachers, special education resource room teachers, and integrated special education co-teachers.
- Program includes a sequence in each English, History, Math, and Science.

M.S. and Advanced Certificate in Applied Behavior Analysis

- This 2-year program will prepare students to become licensed independent practitioners of ABA.
- Courses include didactic, interactive, and clinical components.
- Students will obtain 150 hours of supervised clinical work under the direction of a Licensed Behavior Analyst.
