Dear Colleagues,

I am writing to let you know that the dates of the repaving project have changed.

We will begin by resurfacing from the main entrance up to Canavan Hall and from the Curtis Hall Getzville entrance up to Canavan. This will include all the parking lots in that quadrant, including the lot in front of Thomas Reynolds and the side of Canavan, the circle off of the entrance in front of the VPAC, and in front of Canavan where the new curbs were recently installed.

In order to accomplish this project, we will need to **prohibit all traffic and parking** on that section of campus for a two-day period: **Wednesday, the 27th and Thursday the 28th**. Please do not park or drive in that area beginning at the close of business on Tuesday until Friday morning. To be clear: this means that the main entrance and the Curtis Hall Getzville entrance will not be accessible during that period.

Again, I realize that this is an inconvenience, but I think you will be happy with the results.
