I hope you are enjoying the spring and perhaps some time away. I am writing with a brief but important update.

The State Department of Transportation has begun work on renovating and widening a storm water drainage system that extends under Main Street from Amherst High to Daemen's property. Beginning on June 8, traffic on Main Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction throughout the entire summer. The DOT expects to complete the project by August 31, but this is only a tentative date. You may want to enter and exit Daemen from one of our other entrances this summer.

On a more pleasant note, work on the extension of our stone wall should begin in the next week or two. We have permission to include a smaller version of the front entry sign at the Main/Getzville corner. This should be a very attractive addition to the campus.
