- -Preference for students with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- -Must have applied/be enrolled in an approved accredited study abroad or Daemen Faculty-led program.
- -International internships are eligible only if it is in tandem with an approved accredited overseas study program.
- -If selected, recipients agree to acknowledge and express appreciation of the award in writing within 6 weeks of notification to the Gliozzo Family.

ESSAY

- -Attach typed essay to your completed application form.
- -Essay must be typed in 12 pt. font, single spaced, 1 inch margins, with a maximum of 2 pages in length.
- -Please include your name, country, and program information at the top of each page.
- -Your essay should be a clear, concise statement. Please *proof-read* prior to submission.

Prompt: Describe how the country and specific program you selected will help you achieve your academic and future career goals. Explain why participating in your study abroad program is the best way to accomplish the goals you describe. Applicants with financial need or who are traditionally under-represented* in study abroad should include the impact these elements have had on their decision to study abroad.

- *Under-represented students include those who have transferred to Daemen from a community college, veterans, first-generation** college students, participants of semester-long programs, STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) majors, HEOP/Vision students, and students planning to study a language/in a language other than English.
- **First-generation = neither parent has a 4-year college degree.
